



Elko County Republican Party Platform

Adopted in Convention February 21st, 2026

1. We recognize that our rights as human beings come from God, as stated in the Declaration of Independence, and that no government has the right to abridge them.
2. We believe that the nuclear family is the basic foundation of civilization and, as such, government policy should serve to strengthen it.
3. We support limited and accountable government, lower taxes, less regulation, fiscal responsibility, and more personal accountability.
4. We support Constitutional government and demand that each branch adhere strictly to the powers and limitations granted to it by the Constitution.
5. We strongly affirm the Second Amendment that guarantees the individual's right to keep and bear arms without infringement.
6. We support the full protections of the Fourth and Fifth Amendments and oppose any policy that removes Constitutional rights without due process and lawful judicial procedure.
7. We expect the State and Federal governments to follow the Tenth Amendment, as the Founders intended.
8. We support our federal system designed to bring government close to the people by preserving local government as the foundation of governance.
9. We recognize the sovereignty of the United States of America and oppose any law, treaty, or action which would subject her to the jurisdiction of any international organization, court, or law.
10. While keeping secure borders, we welcome legal immigrants from all nations, cultures, creeds, and races who embrace the Constitution of the United States and assimilate to the United States of America without burden.
11. In order to promote free and fair elections by legal U.S. citizens, we support voter identification, in-person voting, and verified absentee voting, while opposing same day voter registration, universal mail-in ballots, and ballot harvesting.
12. We recognize the right to life as identified in the Declaration of Independence. We assert life begins at conception and lasts until natural death.
13. We assert that parents have the right to choose the best education for their children, including charter, private, public, home, or vocational schools. We further assert that education is a state and local responsibility and that public school funding should follow the child. We believe in the academic fundamentals of reading, writing, arithmetic, history, science, and civics.
14. In order to promote economic growth and job creation, we support Nevada small business and industry, including mineral exploration, mining, agriculture, and gaming, to remain free and independent, with limited government regulation and taxation.

15. We support responsible stewardship of Nevada's public lands that protects natural resources, strengthens water sustainability, and promotes economic growth.

16. We believe in safeguarding the fundamental rights of individuals in the digital age, protecting free speech, digital privacy, and personal autonomy for all adults. We oppose censorship, government overreach, and any infringement upon the Constitutional rights guaranteed by the First and Fourth Amendments. Technology should enhance, not infringe upon our freedoms.

Justification for order of planks:

This platform is designed to take a God, family, country approach beginning with the most fundamental statements of belief in our Creator and family upon which all else can be built. Following these, the next planks focus on reaffirming our belief in our constitutional republic government, and our assertions by which that government must thrive.
