VOTERS WITH DISABILITIES

VOTER ASSISTANCE

At the direction of a voter who has a physical disability, is at least 65 years of age or is unable to read or write, a person may mark a ballot and sign the envelope on behalf of the voter or assist the voter to mark a ballot and sign the envelope pursuant to this section. If a person marks a ballot and signs the envelope on behalf of a voter pursuant to this section, the person must indicate next to his or her signature that the mail ballot and envelope have been marked and signed on behalf of the voter. If a person assists a voter to mark a ballot and sign the envelope pursuant to this section, the person or the voter must include on the return envelope his or her name, address, and signature.

If you did not receive a mail ballot or need a replacement ballot, please contact the Clerk's Office on or before June 2, 2026.

VOTING AT THE POLLS

If you plan to vote at the polls, you may bring your mail ballot to surrender to an Election Worker or, if you do not bring your mail ballot, you must complete an affirmation indicating that you are not voting more than once in the same election prior to casting a ballot.

If you have any questions or concerns about the voting machine or you do not see the candidates you expected to see on your ballot, please stop voting and request assistance from an Election Worker. Once you cast your ballot, you cannot make changes.

ASSISTANCE WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR VOTERS IF NEEDED. Ask an Election Worker for assistance: If you need help reading the ballot or operating the voting machine.






If you think you have received an incorrect ballot style. Do not cast your ballot.

IDENTIFICATION MAY BE REQUIRED if you registered to vote by mail or computer and did not provide identification at the time of registering. Proof of residence may also be required if your identification does not list your physical address.

YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO APPEAR IN PERSON if you make changes to your voter registration online between May 13, 2026, and June 9, 2026. IDENTIFICATION WILL BE REQUIRED. Proof of residence may also be required if your identification does not list your physical address.

New Voting Technology Update: Ballot Marking Devices

Elko County is implementing updated voting technology to enhance the in-person voting experience. Voters will now use a **Ballot Marking Device (BMD)** when voting at a vote center.
