



A Resolution of the Elko County Republican Party Supporting Adoption of Gold and Silver Instruments as Legal Tender in Nevada

Whereas Elko County is among the largest contributors to the world's supply of gold bullion, and

Whereas precious metals have been used as a transfer of wealth for all of human history, and

Whereas fiat currency has been shown to be vulnerable to inflation and non-market forces, and

Whereas legal precedence established in Lane County vs Oregon (1868) acknowledges the Constitutional authority of states to specify legal tender, and by the end of 2022 six states have enacted legislation recognizing gold and silver instruments as legal tender,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Elko County Republican Party supports and promotes the adoption of gold and silver instruments as species legal tender through addition to Nevada Revised Statutes or amendment to the Nevada State Constitution.
